

## **Job Announcement**

### **On-Site Local Public Health Agency Accreditation Reviewer**

The Missouri Institute for Community Health (MICH) Accreditation Program is seeking qualified individuals to serve as members of a team that conducts on-site reviews of local public health agencies seeking voluntary accreditation. Reviewers may make up to 3 site visits a year and have the right to decline an assignment.

Responsibilities include:

- Objective evaluation of agency performance in meeting accreditation standards
- Identification of evidence-based practices in agencies applying for accreditation
- Review of on-line documentation
- Work with another reviewer at an on-site visit

This is an opportunity to observe public health at the community level in a variety of settings. Reviewers gain a broad understanding of the problems, practices and accomplishments of public health practitioners working in local public health agencies.

Required qualifications:

- Master in Public Health, or
- Bachelor's Degree plus experience in public health, and
- Currently employed in a public health setting (or within the last three years).

Compensation includes up to \$400.00 for on-line review of documentation, and \$200 per day for the site visit, and travel related expenses including meals and lodging. Training for reviewers will be provided prior to a site visit.
